The 550 acre facility has been serving the camp community for over 100 years. There is a centralized camp with a large dining hall and a campfire area with cabins and individual toilet/shower facilities located nearby. West Valley Creek rambles through the property that includes forested hills, meadows and wetlands as well as sports facilities and a pool. There is also a small pond for canoeing and fishing.
